

# *Our Sprouts Day*

Time	Activity	We are Learning...
9:30-10:00	Arrival and Morning routine	Students find their name on the hook outside of the classroom and hang coats and backpack and say goodbye to family.
	Morning Work	Students do two activities at the table and two on the floor. Activities are often connected to our theme of the week, chapel story, or letter of the week. Floor activities may include blocks, kitchen play, dolls, or a sensory bin. Students are working on artistic abilities, fine and gross motor skills, cutting, literacy, and numbers.
10:00-10:15	Bathroom / Hand washing	Children and teachers go as a group to the restroom and use the facilities one at a time. Children wash their hands with soap and water and dry with paper towels.
10:15 - 11:10	Circle Time	Children are learning about the calendar and the weather through an introduction to the months of the year, counting the days, learning the days of the week and discussing the weather and how it applies to their day. They also review the alphabet each day. A prayer for our snack is included.
	Book Time	A book is read relating to the theme or teacher's choice to the students during snack time. After snack, children choose a book to enjoy independently while sitting on the carpet.
11:10 - 11:20	Bathroom / Hand washing	Students use the bathroom if needed. All students wash their hands.
11:20-11:40	Recess	Children play on our fenced in playground as weather permits. If needed, children enjoy the bounce house, two at a time.
11:40-12:10	Learning Through Play	Children are offered the opportunity to learn with puzzles, blocks, pegs, stringing beads and shapes, building with blocks and other preschool activities.
12:10-12:25	Chapel/Music	<p>Students attend Chapel with Pastor Mark to experience God's love and power through Bible verses, stories and character lessons.</p> <p>During Music students learn and sing songs and learn American Sign Language</p>
12:25-12:30	Show and Tell and Dismissal	<p>Students practicing speaking to their friends and telling about their show and tell items.</p> <p>A goodbye song ends our day</p>

Our preschool day has a mix of student lead, play based, and teacher directed lessons and activities. We infuse movement throughout the day and take a child's attention span into consideration as well.

This is our daily routine. However, it may be adjusted based on students' needs, situations (fire drills, etc.) and classroom events.
